General Tools

- ☐ rotary tool with blade and wire brush bits
- ☐ drill
- ☐ black marker
- ☐ paper and pencil
- ☐ masking tape
- ☐ ruler

- ☐ natural-bristle brush
- ☐ cloth and latex gloves
- ☐ paper towels and glass cleaner
- ☐ industrial fan
- ☐ shop vacuum or small broom for cleanup

Glasswork

- ☐ glass cutter
- ☐ cutting oil
- ☐ breaker pliers
- ☐ safety glasses
- ☐ four 1' square panes of clear glass

Soldering and Re-Caming

- ☐ soldering iron
- ☐ 60/40 solder
- ☐ iron tip cleaner (a sponge held in a plastic container)
- ☐ flux and flux brushes
- ☐ H-shaped flat lead came
- ☐ German glazing nails
- ☐ lead nippers
